

27-65 Data Reporting Requirements

Most Notable Changes

- **Data Type:** 27-65 designated facilities must now submit disaggregated data (previously aggregated data)
- **Client-Level Data:** BHA requires, as of 07/01/2024, that both 27-65 Designated Facilities and ED/Non-Designated Facilities submit client-level data regarding 27-65 services. HB 22-1256 (Data Requirements for EMS Facilities Part 11.5.9)
- **Placement Data:** BHA requires 27-65 service providers to submit data related to client placement and any issues related to placing individuals in the appropriate level of care; subsequent hold data

27-65 Data Reporting Requirements Cont'd

11.5.9 Data Requirements for Emergency Medical Services Facilities [Effective 7.1.24]

- An emergency medical services facility is required to maintain a data set sufficient to report the following disaggregate numbers to BHA annually [pursuant to Section 27-65-106(9), C.R.S.]:
 - The name, county, and address of each facility site where the service was provided.
 - Gender;
 - Race and ethnicity;
 - County of residence;
 - If the individual arrived through an emergency transportation hold;
 - A record of each individual who had an involuntary emergency mental health hold resolved;

27-65 Data Reporting Requirements Cont'd

11.5.9 Cont'd...

- The outcome of each individual involuntary emergency mental health hold resolved at the facility:
 - Released without the need for further mental health services;
 - Referred for voluntary treatment; or
 - Transferred to a 27-65 designated facility for continued involuntary services.
- Who initiated the involuntary emergency mental health hold:
 - Certified peace officer;
 - Court; or
 - Intervening professional.
- The reason for the involuntary emergency mental health hold:
 - Dangerous to self;
 - Dangerous to others; or
 - Gravely disabled.
