M-0.5 - Emergency Transportation Hold



"Probable cause to believe a person is experiencing a behavioral health crisis or is gravely disabled and, as a result, without professional intervention the person may be a danger to the person's self or others."

Prior to the hold:

⇒Shall access a Crisis Response Team if they can come in a "timely manner.

⇒May not be transported if an intervening professional has determined emergency mental health hold criteria is not met.

Do not use if the individual is experiencing a medical crisis—that takes priority!

Limitations:

⇒Transportation cannot take longer than 6 hours

⇒The hold cannot last longer than <u>14</u> hours.

The individual must be screened immediately/ASAP at the facility (within 8 hours).

⇒If taken to an ED, the hold expires upon the ED receiving the individual for screening.
